

Application Guide April 2026



1. Entry Requirements

- (1) Persons who have completed (or are expected to complete) at least 12 years of formal education or an equivalent.
- (2) Persons who have been (or are expected to be) granted permission to enter Japan through proper procedures.
- (3) Persons who have the financial ability to cover tuition and living expenses during their period of study, or who have a relative with such financial ability.
- (4) Persons who possess Japanese language proficiency equivalent to A1 level or higher.
- (5) Persons who have completed at least 150 hours of Japanese language study, or who have passed a Japanese language test equivalent to A1 level or higher.

- * A processing fee of 22,000 yen will be charged upon an interview.
- * "Others" includes fees for learning materials, faculty maintenance, foreign student insurance, health maintenance, and school activities.
- * All students will need to join the national insurance and the national pension plans and pay their premiums. Students can apply for reductions at their local municipal office.
- * The next payment will be 419,000 yen (for 6 months).
- * The school might not accept applicants depending on their history of previous applications for a student visa or if they have resided in Japan under other types of visas.
- * If the applicant's nationality is not on the list of the specific countries or regions, please consult with the school.

^{*}Note: For those with a bachelor's degree or higher, requirement (5) is not mandatory.
